David Laycock has been appointed as centre director for Land Securities' landmark £350 million Trinity Leeds development.



The 1m sq ft shopping and leisure scheme, which opens in spring 2013, is transforming Leeds city centre and David, who brings considerable experience of launching and managing new centres, has an important role to play in building the community profile of the UK's largest on-going retail-led development.
